



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 20th, 2017



Representatives of the Manitoba Hazardous Waste Management Corporation will be on hand for the safe packaging and disposal of hazardous materials.

A Town vehicle will be available to assist those special needs people with the pick-up and delivery of waste to the collection depot. Prior arrangements will be required.

Common items brought to the depot include pesticides, insecticides, herbicides, antifreeze, furniture polishes and waxes, wood preservatives, household cleaners, toilet and drain cleaners, acids, metal polishers, paint strippers, solvents, old paint(is also accepted at the Recycling Centre(not curb side pickup)), rust remover, butane, degreasers, glues, aerosol cans, propane, acetylene, mercury and thermometers. Materials should be left in their original containers where possible, and the contents of each container clearly marked.

ITEMS NO LONGER ACCEPTED AT THIS EVENT ARE:

- Batteries (car & household) Can be recycled at the Recycling Centre (Must be taken to the Recycle Centre not put in the curb side pick-up)
- Oil and products – these items can be dropped off at the Oil Depot Centre located at the landfill site
- Pharmaceuticals(talk with your pharmacist on how and where to dispose of (typically pharmacies will take old or unused drugs))
- Electronics can be recycled at the Recycling Centre
- Florescent & LED bulbs Can be recycled at the Recycling Centre
- Hazardous wastes generated by Commercial Operations
